desirous of obtaining a lease of the Backen front of Lot No.
25 in front of the 1st Concession of the said Township of Hope
a Reserve - That he is prepared to comply with the Regulations
of the 4th of April 1811 and humbly offers Stephen Bedford
of this Township, Norman in a surety for the regular
payment of the Rent -

Honor would be pleased to grant him a lease of the said Lot
